



Content that will be added to the final brochures will describe each level of participation in Spanish, Hmong or English.

- UNO (IB, ONE) Request to accept the learning opportunity. Comes with native-language reading material, a supporting website and seed packages for carrots and radishes.
- DOS (OB, TWO) Request to attend occasional neighborhood gatherings to discuss gardening (indoor and outdoor) and use of fresh vegetables in cooking. Request to distribute the UNO supplies and answer questions. Comes with nutrition information and tomato plants.
- TRES (PEB, THREE) Request to become more involved in the network, working with community resources including cooking demonstrations and community gardening. Comes with sunflower seeds and cabbage plants.
- CUATRO (PLAUB, FOUR) Request to become community resources by assisting neighbors, and organizing food events at church and in schools. Comes with strawberry plants and herbs.

Design Notes

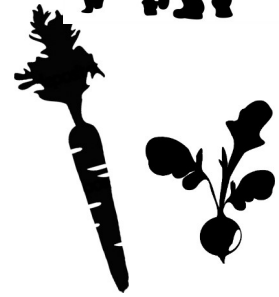
- Each handout can feature two languages, one on each side.

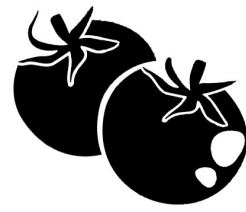
Our Food family



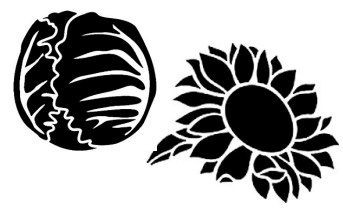
Uno produce
